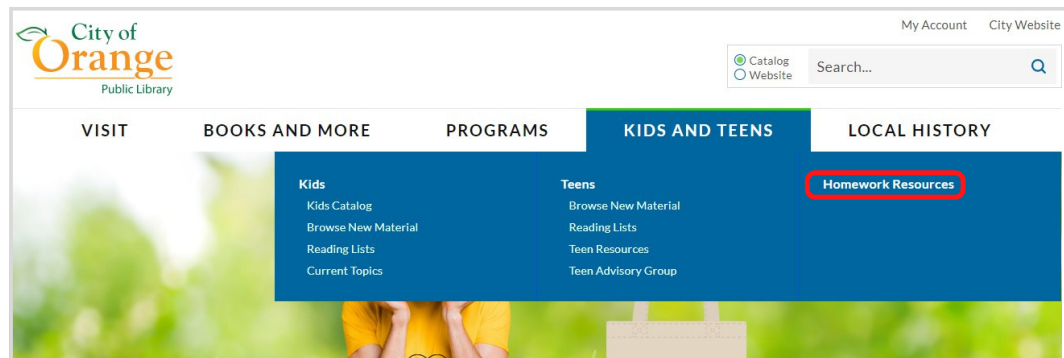


Research Guide - Using Encyclopedia Britannica

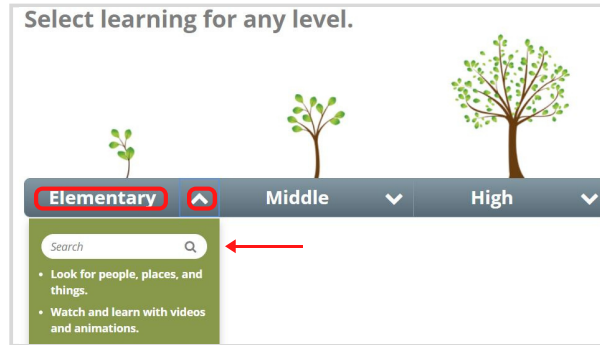

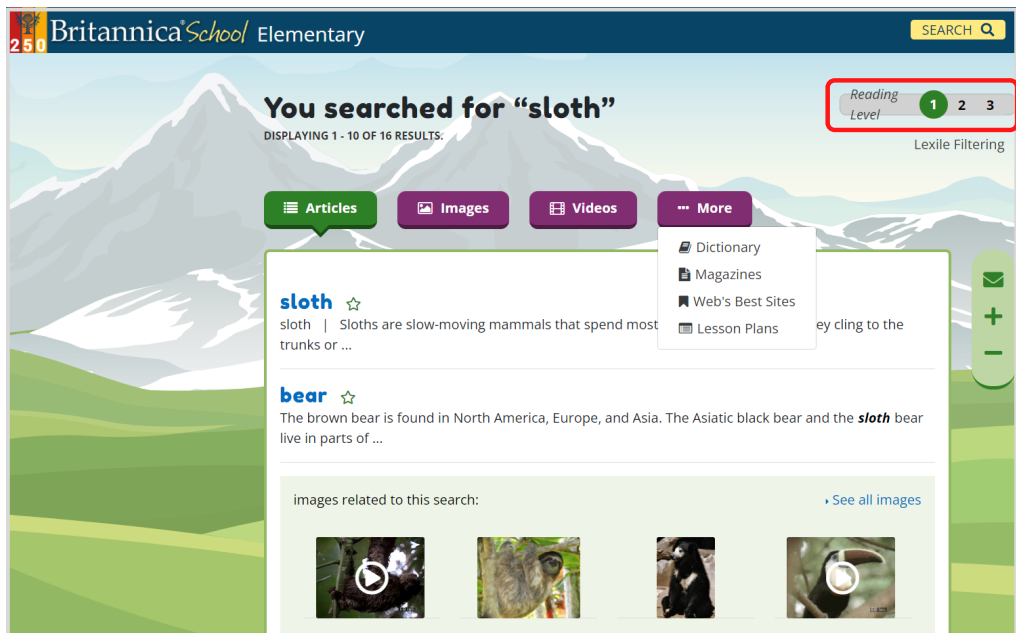
- Select your learning level: elementary, middle, or high. You can do a quick search using keywords by clicking on the arrow for your learning level.



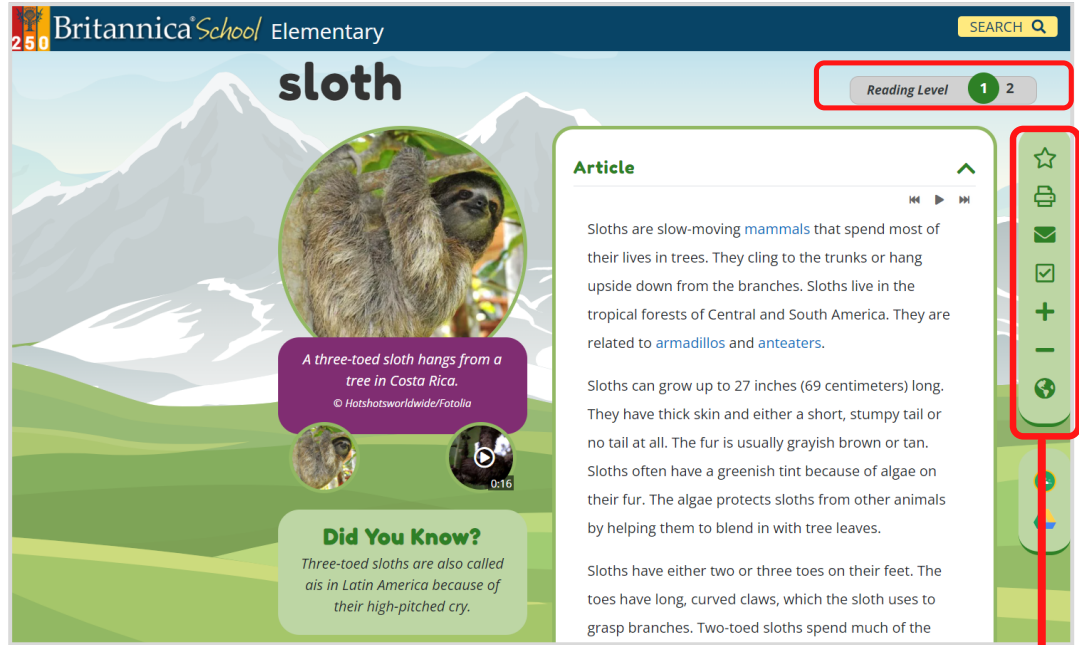
- Once you enter your learning level, begin searching by entering keywords in the search box.
