The Orange Public Library & History Center has a Homework Center for children in grades 1-6. The Homework Center offers after school homework assistance by Homework Helper volunteers. This program focuses on homework assignments and does not provide childcare services or tutoring; volunteers and library staff members cannot assume responsibility for children left alone in the library.

All Homework Center users must abide by the following rules and guidelines:

1. Parent/Guardian must sign the child in and out each time that child enters and leaves the Homework Center.
2. All children 12 and under using the Homework Centers must have a parent/guardian within the library at all times. Parent/Guardian must remain in the Children's Library if their children are 7 or younger.
3. The Homework Centers may not be used for commercial purposes or activities for which a fee is charged (such as privately paid tutors).
4. The Homework Center will close if a volunteer is not available to supervise.
5. The Homework Center may be used for classes and programs outside of Homework Help hours. These classes and programs require pre-approval and scheduling by staff. All participants must use only the equipment specified in initial agreement and abide by the rules in the Study Room Policy.

The Library's Rules of Conduct Policy applies to the Homework Center.
